# 2024 scale changes

NCCT has updated its scale scores to better align with evolving educational standards and industry requirements, ensuring a more accurate and relevant assessment of candidate performance. These enhancements reflect NCCT's commitment to providing the highest quality certification and evaluation services for healthcare professionals.

The change is moving away from a smaller scale, which was often confused with a percentage, to a larger scale. We hope that this larger scale will be difficult to misinterpret as a percentage. The old scale ranged from 0 to 100, the new scale ranges from 200 to 720. If you achieved a 70 or higher on the old scale, you would pass. If you achieve a 575 or higher on the new scale, you will pass.
